



4-payment plan installment (a processing fee of \$40.00 will be applied to this payment option which will make the total amount due to IACT \$1,696.00): Payment schedule is as follows:

2nd payment of \$424.00 due January 1, 2026

3rd payment of \$424.00 due March 1, 2026
