

Site Control Committee Meetings Now on the 4th Saturday

Site Control Committee meetings have been changed to the 4th Saturday of the month. They will no longer be held on the 2nd Saturday of each month. It always has wonderful information for upcoming events and happenings in IACT.

Flood Zone Reminder

It has been brought to our attention that when new property owners are buying lots in the flood zones, they are not being told this information. If you do not know if your property is in a flood zone, please contact us and ask. There is a map in the Site Control office that states the Flood Zone for your viewing. As for the county prohibits the building of any decks, sheds, platforms – pretty much everything in this area. So again, when in doubt ask.

Do I Need a Permit?

Many have stopped by the office to get the necessary paperwork for improvements on their lots. Please remember that if you are unsure whether you need a permit for a particular improvement please reach out and ask. I would rather you ask questions than do things that could potentially get you in trouble and potential fines.

Upcoming Site Control Seminars

Don't forget that this Saturday, March 1, 2025, from 11-1pm, that Matt from Po River Water & Sewage will be at the clubhouse to meet with members and answer any questions. Matt will be able to answer all your questions and will be speaking on Sanitizing your water lines when the water comes back on to your lot. April 5, 2025, we will be hosting Master Gardner Lori Mitzel. This will be at 1:30pm following the Town Hall in the Clubhouse. So come on out and learn how to plant native perennial plants and bring in nature to build habitats for the birds and animals. She will also be covering what plants to stay away from when purchasing that could potentially be harmful to the environment.


