Starting to see a lot of people rolling in to get things ready for the open season. Please remember to get your permits ahead of the project being done and post them. All permits must be posted on the lot before any work is started to avoid penalties.

Don't forget to come out for the Educational Session on April 5, we will be hosting Lori Mitzel, a Master Gardener. We will start at 1:30 right after the Town Hall meeting.

Then on May 3, 2025, we will be hosting the Fire Department. They will be sharing lots of wonderful information with us about fire safety.

#### **Electrical Risers**

Let's talk about Electrical Risers for a minute. We have found that some property owners are putting chains and cables on these. That is not allowed. Maintenance needs to be able to always access these Risers and not have to wait on someone to remove a cable or chain. They will be cut and left. So, if you have one on your riser please remove. Also, no covers on the risers are allowed either. I have seen a few with buckets on top of them as well. When we ride by, we cannot tell if there is smoke or something else that may be going on that needs immediate attention if you have it covered.

#### **Road Work**

Many have commented on our roads being done. Please be courteous while doing work to your lot. Take care of how you back out into the road with your equipment, so you don't tear the roads up. If you do that, it causes more work that has to be done to fix the issues. Remember you are responsible for all the damage done to your lot and surrounding lots by your vendors.





Welcome to the 2025 camping season, Glen 3 Funsteaders!

The activities calendar is starting to get filled up. On Saturday, April 5th,

IACT has scheduled a Spring Clean-Up Event. Usually that means there will be extra dumpsters up by the Trading Post and IACT Maintenance will pick up bagged leaves from your lot.
