Happy New Year to all the Glen 3 Funsteaders that read this bulletin entry for January 2025. It is my hope that your Christmas and New Year's celebrations were safe and festive. It is now Resolution Season, so get out there and make those resolutions and do whatever it takes for you to keep them.

Progress is being made on the Lake Pocahontas dam project. As you know, the water in Lake Pocahontas was lowered to accommodate project construction.

The lowered lake water level leaves approximately 10-15 feet of dry land between the current water line and the usual water line. It is my hope that in the near future, the Lake Pocahontas Dam project will reach a near-completion point where the lake water level will be allowed to return to normal. NOW is the time for lake front property owners to take advantage of the situation and remove leaves and weeds so the property will be relatively "clean" when the normal water line returns.

The Glen Chief usually visits Glen 3 at least once during each winter month and if he sees anything "funny" on a Glen 3 property, he will notify Security.
